Griffith Central underway

AFTER an agonising wait, work has finally begun at the Peninsula Group development, Griffith Central.

Three years ago council received the development application for the Yambil Street site, and several extensions were granted while the group tried to sign an anchor tenant.

But Peninsula Group CEO Simon

Morris confirmed initial works have started on the site and said he is looking forward to the project getting completely underway.

"Works have commenced to facilitate the project as planned," Mr Morris said.

"We are very excited to bring this kind of facility to the

community of Griffith."

The Griffith Central site has already signed two major anchor tenants with Ritchies IGA and Target.

The site is also expected to have an underground car park with 50 parking spaces, a 200 plus seat food court and over 40 specialty stores.
